It is important to us here at the IILM University, that our students get the best possible opportunity for learning from their time here. The IILM University has a disciplinary policy against any behavior that is seen as disrupting "the teaching, study, research or administration of the University". This document has been written and circulated to ensure that we all have a common understanding of what such behaviors are, and that we can all play our part in making the learning experience for all at the Institute an enjoyable one.

To ensure the high level of trust which business organizations have placed on our programme and students, we would like to ensure that our students follow exemplary behavior while pursuing their studies.

To ensure that all benefit as much as possible from their time at the University, it is important to identify areas of behavior that the University believes disrupt teaching and learning activities. These areas include but are not limited to the following:

- Arriving late for classes without giving any rational explanation.
- Using mobile phones in class.
- Eating whilst in class.
- Talking to other students during class and ignoring requests to be quiet.
- Being abusive towards faculty, staff and other students in and outside class.
- Leaving lectures before the end without permission.
- Failing to attend scheduled lectures, tutorials/special sessions and seminars
- Indulging in unruly behavior or in a fight or brawl with fellow students inside and outside campus,
 - including college sponsored hostel
- Calling students and friends from outside to the campus or class without permission of college
- Authorities
- Carrying drugs/alcohol or any other prohibited material or equipment in the campus.
- Causing damage to college property.
- Going on strike and creating disturbance and indiscipline in campus.

Consequences

The University already has the right to impose appropriate penalties upon students who disrupt the teaching and learning activities of the Institute. Such penalties include removal from appropriate locations, suspension/termination of access to University services and from classes, fines and suspension/termination of registration according to decisions made by the Disciplinary Committee of the IILM University.

- I agree not to behave in a way that disrupts the learning of others nor any teaching activities, and recognize that disciplinary procedures may be initiated against groups and individuals where breach of Institute rules occur.

- I am aware that IILM University monitors my compliance with the behavioral standards set out above including monitoring of my attendance at scheduled lectures and tutorials.
- I am aware that the University may submit copies of student work to a national database set up to detect plagiarism.
- I am aware that that if my attendance falls short in Lectures, my marks may be deducted, or I may not be allowed to take exams or made not eligible for placements.
- I agree to take responsibility of my belongings at the college campus which include Laptop, mobile phone, wallet, books, bags or any other personal item. In case of theft or misplacement, the University authorities will have no responsibility in this.
- I am aware that I have to fully observe the norms of discipline & good conduct and I will not be involved in any activity which could be considered illegal or an offence.
