NOTIFICATION - SPECIAL BACKLOG EXAMINATION
2027 Graduating Batch & 2026 / 2025 Passed-Out Batches

As per the approval of the Competent Authorities, the University is pleased to announce a Special Backlog Examination to provide eligible students an opportunity to clear their pending backlog subjects and fulfil the applicable academic requirements.

1. Eligibility

- Students of the 2027 graduating batch having **one (1), two (2), or three (3) backlog** subjects are eligible to register.
- Students having **more than three (3) backlog subjects are not eligible** for this examination.
- The backlog subjects must be among the courses specifically identified and notified by the University.

2. 2026 & 2025 Passed-Out Batches

Students of the **2026 and 2025 passed-out batches may register through their concerned Department through offline** subject to the following conditions

- The backlog subject must be the same as or equivalent to a subject offered to the present final-year students.
- Equivalency shall be determined based on the subject code and/or subject name, as per the approved curriculum by the department.
- The final decision regarding subject equivalency and eligibility shall rest with the concerned Department and the Controller of Examinations.

3. Registration Duration & Examination Details

Eligible students shall complete registration from 17 August 2026 to 18 August 2026 as specified in the above. The offline registration form must be verified and duly signed by the concerned HoD after confirming the student and course details.

- Examination Fee: ₹1,000/- per subject
- Tentative Examination Commencement: 31 August 2026 onwards
- The detailed date sheet will be communicated separately.
- Only students who complete both registration and fee payment within the stipulated period shall be permitted to appear for the examination.

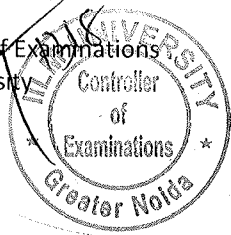
Important Note -
