BA/BSc (Hons) Psychology

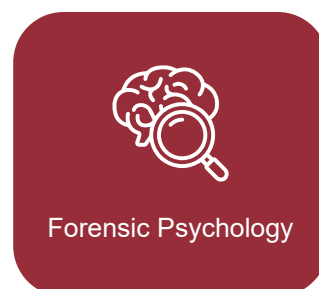
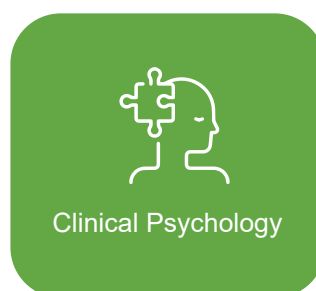

The curriculum includes coursework in key areas such as developmental, cognitive, social, and abnormal psychology.

Students develop critical thinking and analytical skills, with the honours component often involving an in-depth research project or thesis. Graduates are well-equipped for further academic study or for diverse careers in fields like counselling, human resources, and social services.

BSc (Hons) Clinical Psychology (RCI Approved)

This programme provides a comprehensive exploration of the theoretical foundations, practical skills, and ethical considerations necessary for the field of clinical psychology. It is designed to equip you with the knowledge and competencies for entry-level positions in various mental health settings, as well as for further education in psychology. You will delve into core areas such as abnormal psychology, psychological assessment, counselling techniques, and psychotherapy approaches.

MA Psychology

This programme offers a broad understanding of psychological theories, research methods, and their applications. It is designed to foster critical thinking, research skills, and a nuanced understanding of human behaviour. The course equips students for careers in counselling, social services, and other fields that focus on the broader aspects of human behaviour and mental processes. The curriculum includes the latest trends in Psychology, with a special emphasis on practical training and fieldwork.

MSc Psychology

This programme is a more research-oriented study of the human brain and neuroscience. Its primary objective is to develop advanced research skills, critical analysis, and expertise in research and applications within the field of Psychology. Students are prepared for roles in research, academia, and specialised clinical settings. This programme has a stronger emphasis on the scientific and research aspects of psychology, which may involve a focus on experimental design, statistical analysis, and empirical research.

BA (Hons) Psychology

With **specialisations** in **Organisational Behaviour** and **Sports Psychology**, this programme focuses on the social and cultural aspects of human behaviour. You will gain fundamental knowledge of psychological theories and learn how to apply these principles to solve real-world problems in your chosen specialisation. Graduates are prepared for a variety of career paths in healthcare, education, management, and research, among others.

BSc (Hons) Psychology

With **specialisations** in **Forensic Psychology**, **Health Psychology**, **Military Psychology**, and **Clinical Psychology**, this is a rigorous, science-based programme. It provides a profound understanding of the human brain and behaviour by studying the biological aspects of psychology. The curriculum integrates the latest scientific advances in psychopathology, assessment, and intervention, preparing you for a wide range of academic and professional roles. This degree meets international standards for postgraduate education and professional practice, supporting global mobility.

MA Psychology

- ▶ **Industrial & Organisational Psychology:** Learn to apply psychological principles to the workplace to improve employee performance, satisfaction, and **wellbeing**, while enhancing organisational productivity.
- ▶ **Counselling Psychology:** This programme prepares you to address the emotional, social, and psychological needs of individuals. It combines theoretical foundations with hands-on training to develop competencies in **counselling** techniques and therapeutic interventions.

MSc Psychology

- ▶ **Forensic Psychology:** Gain advanced knowledge of psychological principles as they apply to legal, investigative, and correctional contexts. The programme blends theory, research, and practical training to develop expertise in understanding criminal behaviour and working within the justice system.
- ▶ **Cognitive Neuroscience:** This interdisciplinary programme focuses on the study of the brain mechanisms that underlie mental processes such as perception, memory, and decision-making. You will combine psychology, neuroscience, and computational methods to understand how the brain enables cognition and behaviour.
- ▶ **Clinical Psychology:** Designed to develop advanced knowledge and practical skills in understanding, assessing, and treating mental health concerns. The course blends theoretical foundations with hands-on training in psychological assessment, psychotherapy, and evidence-based interventions.

Eligibility

BA (Hons) & BSc (Hons) Programmes

- ▶ **Qualification:** 10+2 or equivalent.
- ▶ **Minimum Score:** 50% aggregate from a recognised board.

MA & MSc Programmes

- ▶ **Qualification:** A relevant Bachelor's degree from a recognised university.
- ▶ **Specifics:** Bachelor's degree in Psychology may be required for some specialisations.

Students gain hands-on experience conducting psychological assessments, behavioural experiments, and data analysis in a professional setting. The lab also houses a wide range of standardised test materials, such as intelligence scales, personality inventories, and diagnostic tools.

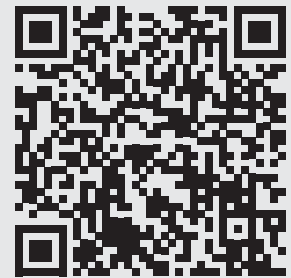
